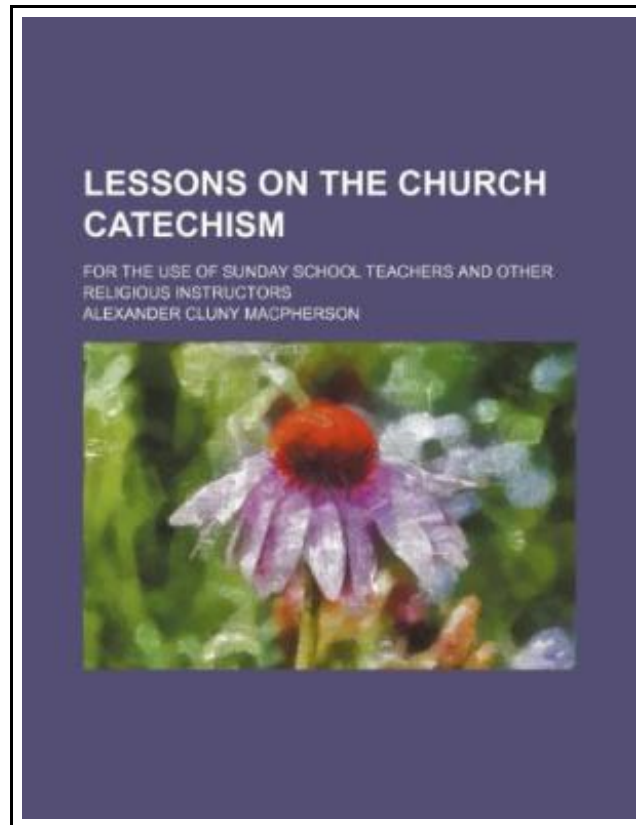

What does the Catechism say this Commandment teaches us Yes, to honour Gods Name, and His Word. Gods Name means everything that belongs to Him. And we must honour Gods Name. You know the verse: --Words that are holy Must be said slowly. And what does Solomon say about it (Eccles. v. 2.) Yes, whenever we use the Name of God, it should be carefully, solemnly, reverently. What does the Bible say about the Name of Jesus (Phil. ii. 9, 11.) And we must also honour Gods Word whatever He says to us, whether by the Bible, or by His ministers, or by His Holy Spirit. And then He says He will honour us (1 Sam. ii. 30). And He will look upon us with His favour (Isa. lxvi. 2). The Name of God is holy, and God will not hold him guiltless that taketh His Name in vain. So whether it be in church, or wherever we have occasion to use the Name of God, let us take...
