This report attempts to provide a comprehensive picture of total federal financial support for education since fiscal year 1980. Federal support for education, excluding estimated federal tax expenditures, was an estimated 128.1 billion in fiscal year 2001, an increase of 65.3 billion since fiscal year 1990. The report divides federal education funding into three categories: (1) on-budget funding for federal programs, generally set through congressional appropriations; (2) off-budget support and nonfederal funds, which are federal monies excluded from the budget by law; and (3) nonfederal funds generated by federal programs, resulting from federal loan guarantees and interest subsidies to support loan capital raised through various private and public sources. Fiscal year 2001 highlights include the following observations: On-budget federal funds for education programs were estimated at 92.8 billion—an increase of 80 percent since FY 1980 in current dollars; a little over 60 percent of federal education support went to educational institutions; and schools and colleges derived 11 percent of their revenues from the federal government, with remaining revenues coming from state and local governments, individuals, and private organizations....
